

LOWER GRANGE FARM



From the M2

Leave the M2 at Junction 3 and follow signs towards Maidstone down Blue Bell Hill (A229).


Midway down Blue Bell Hill take 'Chatham Road' directly after the Shell Petrol Station.

At the cross road turn left into 'Tyland Lane' and follow until you reach another cross road. Turn right into 'Boarley Lane'. This will take you under the motorway bridge. Directly after the bridge take the left hand turn past the 'The Yew Tree' Pub and follow the road for a few hundred meters. Lower Grange Farm is on the right hand side.

From the M20

Leave the M20 at Junction 7 and join the A249 towards Maidstone. At the first roundabout turn right onto 'Bearsted Road' (A249). At the next roundabout go straight across onto 'Penenden Heath Road'. At the next roundabout turn right onto 'Boxley Road' and follow this over the motorway.

Turn left into 'Grange Lane' (directly after where the speed limit changes from 30 to 40mph). Follow Grange Lane until you come to a T-junction. Turn left and go under the motorway bridge. Directly after the bridge take the left hand turn past the 'The Yew Tree' Pub and follow the road for a few hundred meters. Lower Grange Farm is on the right hand side.

- 4 Boxley Parish Council Chairman's Report -
The Chairman gave his annual report on the
activities of the Parish Council in the preceding
year. His report included recognition of the work

volunteer groups - Vinters Valley Trust, Wouderslade
Woods Group (WWG) and Friends of Boxley Warren.
The opening of Dove Hill Allotments was noted and the
work of Bob Hindle, the Clerk, John Brooks, the Royal
and Gurkha Engineers and the support of St Paul's

Scouts acknowledged. Copies of the full report were made available to those present at the meeting and will be published in the Downs Mail and displayed on the website.

5 Financial Report from the Parish Council -

The supporting notes to Boxley Parish Council's accounts for the year ended 31 March 2014 were made available at the meeting and will be posted on the website.

6 To receive Reports from local organisations -

Rob Burrows, chairman WNG, gave a report on recent work and progress in the woods by the volunteers and the group's future plans. He was thanked by the Chairman.

Bob Hinder, chairman Friends of Boxley Warren, gave a report on the work undertaken by the group and future plans, including the creation of viewpoints and hazel coppicing. A seat and two sculptures have recently been installed on the Pilgrim's Way.

Written reports from the Grole Green Community Association and Vinters Valley Trust were received. All written reports were made available to those present at the meeting.

The Chairman presented a KALC Community Awards Scheme certificate to John Brooks, a resident of the parish.
