 The proposal by reason of its design would result in an incongruous and discordant feature detrimental to the Boxley village street scene and conservation area within an AONB.

- If permitted, the scheme would expand the built area of Boxley to the detriment of the character and appearance of the Kent Downs AONB and North Downs Special Landscape Area.
- The development would represent an undesirable extension of the built up area of Boxley contrary to the aims of the Strategic Gap policy.
- Access is via the village green which is narrow and then a narrow access road both of which are unsuited to increased traffic.
- The proposal is not sustainable as it would encourage the use of the private motor vehicle to access services.
- It is development of a greenfield site.
- If the officer is minded to approve the Parish Council request the application be referred to the Planning Committee for determination.
