The Walderslade Woodland Group will give the Clerk a list of what needs to be ordered for the base. Once the base is installed, the container can be ordered and installed and the UTV purchased.

It was agreed to review these trees annually.

#### 9. Walderslade Woodlands

Rob Burrows, chairman of the Walderslade Woodlands Group reported that the Hoods tree inspection report was being worked through with all the trees on the red list being dealt with first. The ones they could not do had been highlighted and given to the Clerk so that she could engage a contractor for the work.

The main focus would be to get signage put in that informs people of where they are and names of places within the woodland. They would also like to get butyl liners for the 2 ponds so that they could be finished and made active. These would be lined with clay.

Patrick Fox now has a dormouse licence and has found dormice in some of the boxes already installed. They were looking at planting some wild honeysuckle to encourage them. The Clerk said that the new dormouse boxes had been purchased and delivery should be very soon.

The Group intended to take some of the significant trees from the plateaus and move them to areas where trees have been lost. Cllr Bryant was obtaining some trees from MBC for planting.

The Facebook page was an issue and needed updating. The Clerk and Jackie Haylock would help with this with Jackie and the Assistant Clerk becoming admins on the page.
