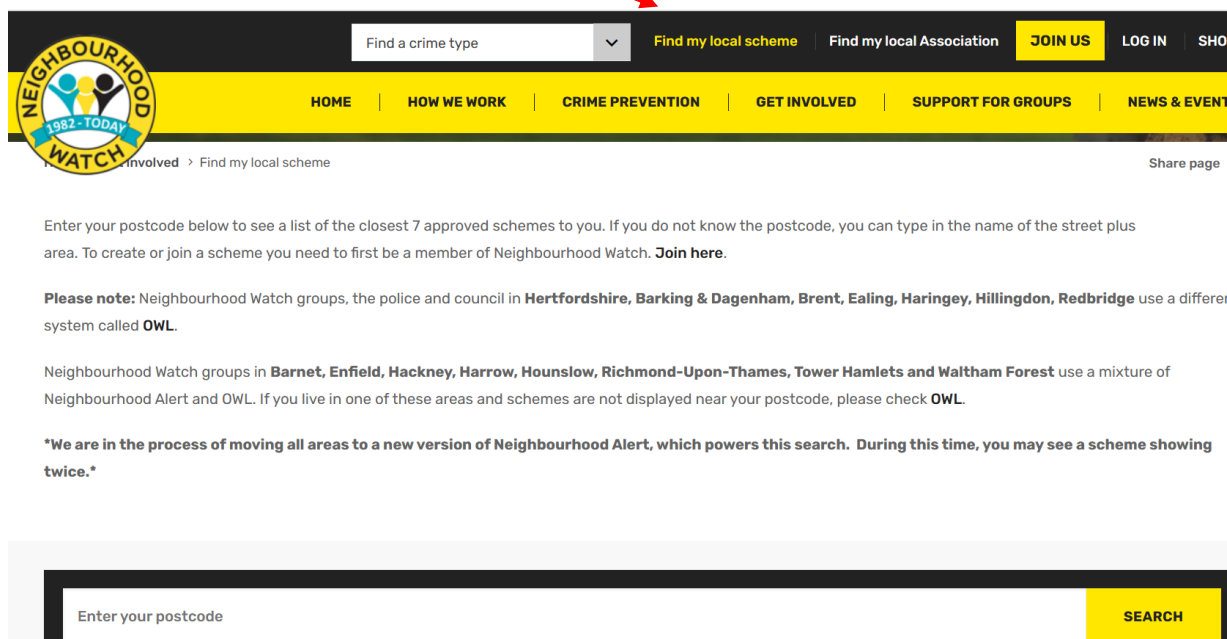


BOXLEY VILLAGE: NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME

Enter your postcode below to see a list of the closest 7 approved schemes to you. If you do not know the postcode, you can type in the name of the street plus area. To create or join a scheme you need to first be a member of Neighbourhood Watch. [Join here](#).

Please note: Neighbourhood Watch groups, the police and council in **Hertfordshire, Barking & Dagenham, Brent, Ealing, Haringey, Hillingdon, Redbridge** use a different system called **OWL**.

Neighbourhood Watch groups in **Barnet, Enfield, Hackney, Harrow, Hounslow, Richmond-Upon-Thames, Tower Hamlets and Waltham Forest** use a mixture of Neighbourhood Alert and OWL. If you live in one of these areas and schemes are not displayed near your postcode, please check **OWL**.

We are in the process of moving all areas to a new version of Neighbourhood Alert, which powers this search. During this time, you may see a scheme showing twice.

Enter your postcode SEARCH

You'll then be asked to enter your post code. From the list of schemes presented select Boxley Village. You will then be asked to join Neighbourhood Watch in order to join your local scheme, Membership is free, and you will gain access to local Neighbourhood Watch news, plus useful hints and tips on security and safety etc.
