Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

**Kent County Council intends to make an Order the effect of
which is to temporarily close:**

- **Public Footpath KH9 between Manor Farm – Dunn Street
and Public Bridleway KH97 near Grange Farm.**
- **Public Bridleway KH97 between Grange Farm and Byway
KH94, and**
- **Byway KH94 between Dunn Street Road at Manor Farm
and Hurstwood Road at its junction with KH38
from the 30 October 2023.**

The paths will be closed for a maximum of six months, although it is expected that it will
reopen by the middle of November 2023.

The paths are to be closed because of danger to the public due to works which are being
carried out to repair the surface of the paths.

Alternative routes will be shown by maps displayed on site.
